HISTORY

In the 1950s further development and expansion in the field of police information in the state Baden-Württemberg

1952
The State Office of Criminal Investigation Baden-Württemberg was founded

In the 1960s introduction of data processing

In the 1970s focus on operation tasks and the fight against terrorism

1971
Undercover investigations established
1972
Swat team introduced
1978
The LKA BW moved to new premises in the Taubenheimstraße 85, Stuttgart Bad-Cannstatt

In the 1980s the new challenge is organised crime and drug trafficking

1984
Unit organised crime – the first one in Germany – installed
1986
Unit synthetic drugs – the first one in Europe – established
1987
Drug prevention presents “anti drug disco”(ADD)

1989
DNA-analyses introduced

The 1990s were marked by the cooperation on the international and national level

1990
Unit witness protection formed
1992
German-French coordination unit formed
1993
Joint investigations team against drugs with LKA BW and customs installed

1995
Joint financial investigations team (money laundering) with LKA BW and customs established

1996
Fugitive unit for targeted searches for selected offenders formed
1997
Task force “skimming of profits” – the first one in Germany – introduced
...

Community based crime prevention safety branch (KKP) installed
1998
Profiling introduced

1999
Joint investigations team with LKA BW and German border police against illegal immigration established
...

The German-French coordination unit becomes permanent as the joint center for police and customs cooperation (Offenburg)

The beginning of the new millennium is marked by crimes in the fields of communication technologies and right wing and Islamist terrorism

2001
Intervention team for right wing extremism established
...
New focus in the field of terrorism (Islamist terrorism)

2002
Department “absorption of capital” is set up, Project group Centre for Internet Skills started

The State Office CID moves into the extension in Taubenheimstraße

2005
The working area “Event-unrelated Online Research” is created
2007

Establishing the antiterror squad “Central Investigation and Hunting Islamist terrorists”
